# **RE: <u>2021 PREMIUM TAX STATEMENT FILING REMINDER</u>**

## 1. <u>FILE A TAX RETURN — NO EXCEPTIONS</u>

<u>All</u> licensed excess line brokers must file a tax return (Premium Tax Statement) **ELECTRONICALLY** on or before March 15, 2022, even if <u>NO</u> business was placed under that license. New York and a number of other states assess up to a \$500 penalty if you fail to file. So, be sure to file tax returns in all states requiring you to do so. Please note that brokers <u>having no business</u> to report may access the New York State Department of Financial Services' (DFS) electronic filing system <u>now</u> to file a "zero" tax return (*See Bulletin 2022-01*). Brokers with premium to report should see #5 below for DFS system availability.

### 2. <u>SUSPENSE AND UNFILED ITEMS</u>

2021 items currently in suspense will <u>not</u> be included in your 2021 ELANY tax summary reports. Members are reminded that any year 2021 suspense items that have not been successfully resubmitted to ELANY for stamping by February 14, 2022, must be included in Section IV (a) of the 2021 Premium Tax Statement.

Also, 2021 items not filed by February 14, 2022, must also be included in Section IV (a) of the 2021 Premium Tax Statement.

Now would be a good time to review monthly reports for any discrepancies and to reconcile your books and records.

### 3. HOW TO FILE A TAX RETURN

### 4. <u>NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES ELECTRONIC TAX FILING</u>

The DFS REQUIRES licensed excess line brokers to file annual premium tax statements electronically through its <u>website</u>. You may apply for an exemption from this requirement and request to file your taxes manually. This request must be submitted in writing to the Superintendent for approval <u>at least 30 days prior</u> to the March 15 filing date.

As explained in the instructions, a broker site ID is required for filing with the Department. If you do not have a broker site ID, contact Han Wang, <u>han.wang@dfs.ny.gov</u> or Jin Wang, <u>jin.wang@dfs.ny.gov</u> with your license number.

### 5. WHEN TO FILE A TAX RETURN

THE DEPARTMENTS' PREMIUM TAX STATEMENT ELECTRONIC PROGRAM FOR ONLINE FILING WILL BE AVAILABLE APPROXIMATELY MARCH 1, 2022.
